- The category of tickets offered will be chosen at the discretion of Les Grands Ballets and per availability.
- Each winner, selected by random draw, will be offered a pair of tickets for one of the above-listed shows. A ticket grants entry to a show. Any additional fees that may be incurred (such as, but not limited to, parking, coat check and beverages) are the responsibility of the individual.
