Announcement of winners and collection of tickets:

Winners will be notified by email as of September 25, 2023 and must confirm their attendance by return email within 5 business days or no later than noon on October 7, 2023. Without confirmation within this timeframe, the pair of tickets will be awarded to another student in a second draw.

Tickets will be available, in the winner's name, at the press table at the entrance to the theatre, one hour before the performance. Proof of identity will be required.
