

# A MONTH OF MAGIC AWAITS WITH THE NUTCRACKER

Montreal, November 16, 2022 - Les Grands Ballets is pleased to present its famous production *The Nutcracker* by Fernand Nault, from December 1 to 4 at the National Arts Center in Ottawa (for the first time since 2006), and then at Place des Arts in Montreal from December 9 to 30.

It is finally time for the young (and not so young!) to rediscover this magical ballet inspired by Hoffman's famous tale. Bringing more than a hundred dancers together, this holiday delight is presented to the public by Les Grands Ballets since 1964. Choreographed by Fernand Nault, the ballet comes alive on the notes of Tchaïkovsky's composition interpreted by Les Grands Ballets Orchestra with conductors Dmitri Zrajevski and Airat Ichmouratov.

After two years of absence, the children will be back on stage for the first act – including the famous Christmas scene where Clara receives her nutcracker – and the show will therefore be presented in its entirety.

Spanning 5 decades, the colorful adventures of Clara in the Land of Snow and the Kingdom of Sweets have enchanted more than 2 million spectators.

#### The Nutcracker in a nutshell:

- The show with the longest run in the same venue across Canada
- 165 characters on stage;
- More than 300 people are directly involved in the production;
- More than 350 costumes.

#### SHARE THE MAGIC OF THE NUTCRACKER

By buying a ticket for *The Nutcracker* ballet, every audience member is involved in a good cause as 2\$ from each sale is donated to **The Nutcracker Fund for Children**. This year, 2,800 children, including 1,400 children coming from disadvantaged backgrounds and 1,400 children experiencing illness attend a complete run of *The Nutcracker*, with the orchestra, for free. Among those children, 1,400 will take part in workshops in schools, organized in collaboration with *Une école montréalaise pour tous* (a program of Quebec's Ministère de l'Éducation).

Additional workshops are organized in several foundations, for example with Le Phare: the dancers will visit hospitalized children, with the artistic director of the company, Ivan Cavallari.

The fund also supports the show's production such as the refurbishing of the sets and costumes.
